



Lovely Lattice

Free Mini Quilt Pattern

Fabric

Main print - suitable for large print
4 coordinating blenders/small prints

Cutting - Main Print

Full square: cut ONE 8½" x 8½" square.
Half-square triangle (sides): cut TWO 9" x 9" squares; cut in half diagonally one time - FOUR triangles.
Small triangle (corners): cut TWO 6" x 6" squares, cut in half diagonally one time - FOUR triangles.

Cutting & Piecing - Blenders

For all four fabrics: cut TWO 1½" strips.
Choose fabric order for strips. *STYLE NOTE: don't place dark fabrics on the outside of sets - this can look like a swastika when pieced!*

Sew together in full strips. Should measure 4½" wide. Press seams to one side.

Cut strip-sets into 4½" x 4½" squares. Sew together in pairs: one with strips vertical, one horizontal, *fig 1*.

Press towards vertical square. Place pairs together, matching center seams; sew together, *fig 2*.

Makes FOUR blocks.

Assembly & Finishing

This quilt is set *on point*. Your rows will be on the diagonal! Lay out as in the illustration. Sew rows together in diagonal strips, *fig 3*. Press seams toward the large print pieces. Sew strips together, matching seams. Press seams to one side.

Add borders and finish as desired!

Finished size: approx 23" x 23" before borders.

Great for a pillow sham or small hanging!

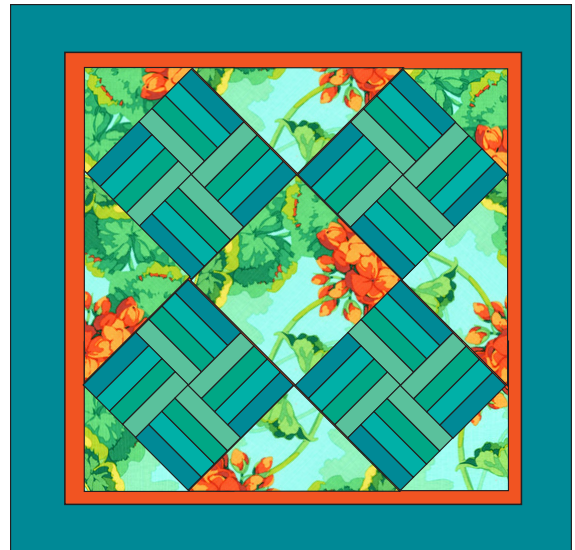

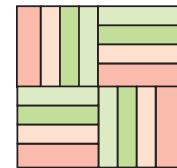

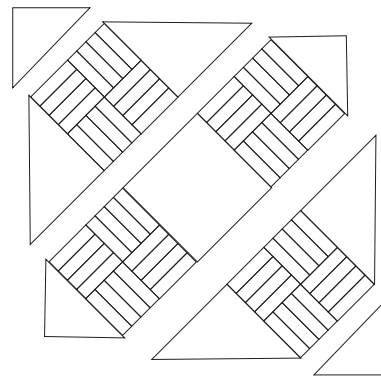
